- On the Home page click the **Students** button. You will have the option to either **Add New** students or **Buy Ticket** for existing students.
- Click **Buy Ticket** beside the **Festive Turkey Luncheon** option, and request one ticket for every child listed on the parent account.
- You can pay for each student on your account in one payment transaction, once all tickets have been ordered.
- You must order lunch tickets online but you have the option (as with the Lunch Program) to send in cash or cheque to the office for payment. Payment in full due immediately.
- If you pay cash/cheque please print a **remittance form** and attach it to your payment so we know to mark your account as paid.
