1. Principal's and Vice Principal's Reports

Principal Update

- staff thankful for support from parents and engagement from students
- planning something for grade 8 grad and gift for grads (water bottles)
- will arrange a pickup date for items at school for all students
- staff has been talking a lot about destreaming grade 9 math next year
 - o differentiation in the classroom, but no applied/academic courses
 - affects graduation rates and equity
- school calendar for next year is out, looks a bit different than usual
 - usual PD day on last day in June isn't happening but 3 PD days before students start in September; now Friday before Labour Day, and Tuesday and Wednesday after
- expecting to start school in Sept with masks, cohorts, etc.
 - will welcome families back from OCV (about 10 students remaining at OCV next year)
 - o projected to be at 670 students next year; this year just under 600
 - o increase of 2 additional classes, total of 28 homerooms
 - o a few staffing changes for next year (staff leaving, new hires, staff teaching at OCV)
- Middle French Immersion program:
 - o no grade 4s registered; five grade 5s; nine grade 6s
 - will cohort the grade 6s into EFI classes
 - grade 5s will have small cohort for French, social studies and join EFI grade 5s for English, math, arts
- no new spending requests
- report card access will be different: no Compass, need OEN from previous report card, will receive email from School Messenger with link to sign in
- flag at half mast to honour 215 children found at residential school in BC
 - conversations happening in classes
 - o next year, will look at intentional teachings around Indigenous cultures and events
- pride flag also flying this month
 - 4 flag poles attached to cenotaph and 1 flag pole in front of school
 - o provincial flag is there twice; who owns the poles?
 - cenotaph should have Union Jack, Canada, provincial flag, fourth reserved for a visiting dignitary; likely owned by Legion
