

Jar Walk Fundraiser - School Council Event

On Tuesday October 17th we will have our annual Jar Walk fundraising event in the Small Coyote's Den. If you are new to the Jar Walk, here is a summary of how it works.

Families are asked to please donate jars filled with fun items for the students. Your contributions will help make the Jar Walk a success. On October 17th the jars will be displayed. Each will be numbered with an empty bag in front of them. Students can purchase tickets and select the jar they hope to win, placing a ticket in the bag corresponding with their desired jar. At the end of the day, the winners will be selected and the jars sent home with the winners.

On Wednesday October 11th a sheet of tickets will be sent home with each student in **Kindergarten through Grade 5** for families to consider purchasing. These are sent home so students have time to fill in the information. Families are asked to send back tickets (purchased or not) in a plastic ziplock bag with payment. Please make cheques payable to Kars on the Rideau School Council. Teachers will keep these tickets until October 17th at which time they will give the purchased tickets back to the students as they are about to go to the Jar Walk.

Grade 6 to 8 students will have an opportunity to purchase tickets the day before the Jar Walk on Monday, October 16th. Students are asked to bring their money to the foyer outside the office at the school. After purchasing the tickets students are asked to fill in the information and leave the tickets with the sellers. These tickets are placed in a class envelope for teachers to distribute on October 17th as students are about to go into the Jar Walk. Please note that students can also purchase tickets at the Jar Walk during the time slot allocated for their homeroom visit.

In the class envelopes there will also be one FREE ticket for every student to ensure that everyone has at least one opportunity to win one of our fabulous jars.

There will be a schedule set up for when each class will visit the Jar Walk.

Winners will be chosen and jars distributed before the end of the school day.

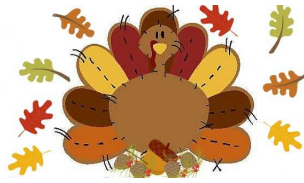
