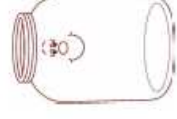
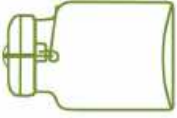
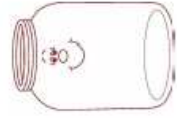
Jar-Walk!!
