Progress Reports/Initial Observations of Learning

Grade 1-8 progress reports and Kindergarten Initial Observation reports will be sent home via email on Wednesday, November 20th. The progress report is designed to share information with parents about their child's general progress early in the school year, focusing on the development of the learning skills and work habits, as well as a student's general progress in working towards their achievement of the curriculum expectations. Progress reports will not include marks or letter grades, but rather progress will be reported by indicating if the student is "progressing with difficulty", "progressing well", or "progressing very well". This report is intended to provide parents with an early indication of their child's progress.

The Kindergarten Initial Observations report is designed to identify and describe the child's learning during the fall of the school year and to provide parents with clear, detailed, and straightforward information about their child's learning, growth in learning, and next steps in learning in relation to the overall expectations in The Kindergarten Program (2016).

A reminder that parent-teacher interviews are being held the evening of Thursday, November 28 and the morning of Friday, November 19th. Teachers will be reaching out to families to coordinate a time for interviews.
