

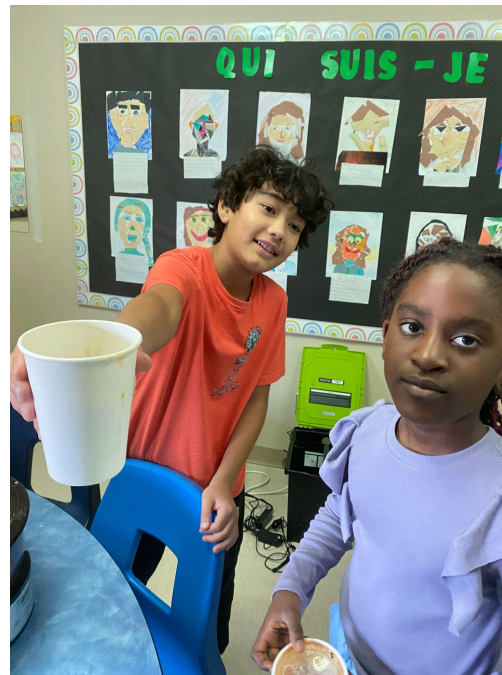
Weekly Family Update
