#### Fresh From the Farm Fundraiser

Fresh from the Farm is an Ontario-based school fundraiser where schools sell bundles of fruits and vegetables grown by Ontario farmers. Schools keep 40% of the total sales, and 50% goes back to participating Ontario farms and farmers. The remaining 10% goes to the Fresh From the Farm organization to cover administrative costs.

We are running the FFF Fundraiser from September 30 - October 15 inclusive. Orders will be available for pickup at the school between November 4 and December 5. The school will

receive a confirmation of our exact delivery date 10 days prior, which we will then communicate to families along with pickup instructions.


