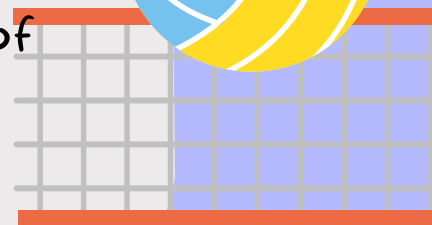

The class R8A recited the poem "In Flanders Field", a now famous poem by a doctor in World War II named John Mcrae.

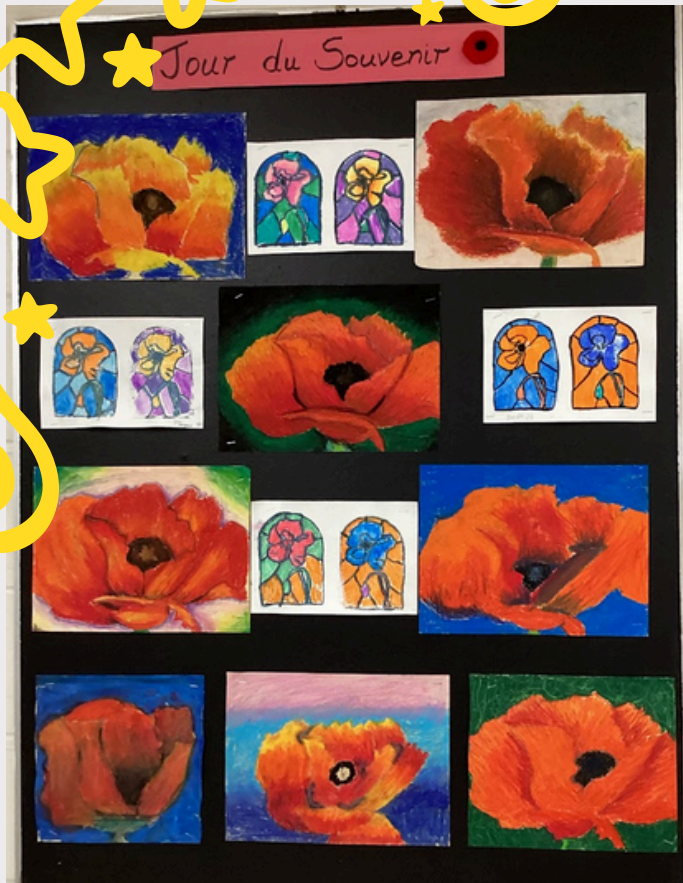
Flanders Field

poppies grow In Flanders fields.

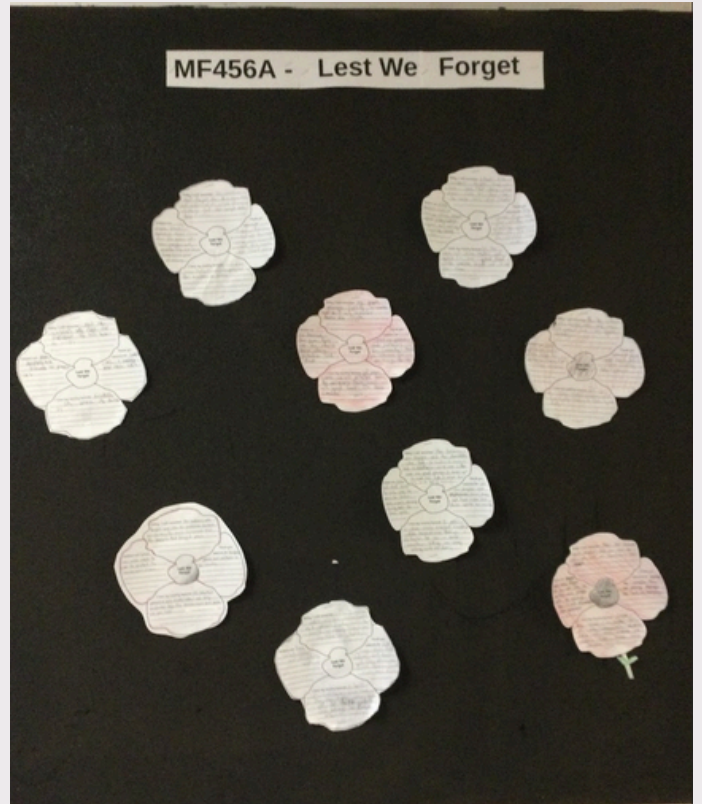

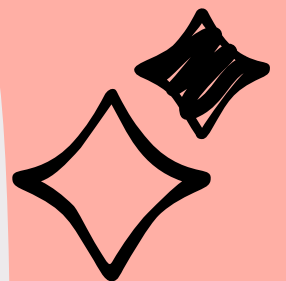


Artwork outside of Mme Denett's classroom
